Christopher and Taylor Malpass, better known as The Malpass Brothers, will bring an evening of traditional country music to the Suffolk Center on Saturday, Jan. 20 at 8:00 p.m.

Although only in their 20s, the brothers have quite a performance record having opened for music legend Merle Haggard on multiple tours and have appeared on stages from the Shetland Islands to Ryman Auditorium to Merlefest. Gifted musicians and songwriters, the brothers have shared billing with artists including Ray Price, Willie Nelson, Doyle Lawson, Rhonda Vincent, Marty Stuart, Doc Watson and more.

The title cut video from their “Memory That Bad” album hit CMT Pure Country’s Top Ten. Their most recent self-titled recording, produced by legend Doyle Lawson, was released in 2015.

Their music is steeped in the legacy of country music greats like Johnny Cash, Marty Robbins, Hank Williams, Sr. and more. They deliver classic country, real country, along with old-time traditional gospels and their own tunes. Personable and interacting with the audience, they provide an evening to remember.
