## Glen McClure: Near and Far, Places and Faces

An exhibit featuring the work of well-known photo-artist Glen McClure will open at the Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts on Thursday, Jan. 18.

Known for his distinctive portraits in black and white, McClure most recently spent the better part of a year visiting local shipyards to photograph local maritime workers. His first solo show in 2002 featured images of people who frequented the area near his downtown Norfolk studio.

McClure also excels in the other extreme of photography: the unpopulated landscape. He loves traveling to other parts of Virginia and the world and his love of travel and the natural elements draws him to photograph the landscapes of Italy, France and especially Ireland.

With over 50 one-man exhibitions of portraits as well as landscape images in his career, his work can be found in museums and private collections. His work can be found in many private and public collections including The Polaroid Collection, Capital One Collection, The Taubman Museum, The Chrysler Museum of Art and The Mariners Museum.
