Summer Camp COVID-19 Guidelines



In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts camp staff will proactively follow guidelines issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Before Camp Guidelines

- Please do not send any child to the camp if anyone in the household is experiencing a cough, runny nose, or temperature of 100+
- All children will have their temperature taken upon arrival and checked for any signs of sickness and any child with a temperature of 100+ will be sent home
- Please pack a water bottle with lunch for daily use

Overall Camp Guidelines

- Social distancing will be observed with chairs spaced 6-feet apart
- All snacks will be individually wrapped
- A sanitation station will be available for all students in each room (sanitizer, wipes, etc.)
- All touchable surfaces will be sanitized before and during camp
- Activities will take place inside and outside to allow for ventilation

Campers Guidelines during camp

- Materials will be kept separate for each student and not shared with others
- Group interaction will be done while adhering to the 6-feet of social distancing
- Campers will receive proper hygiene instruction (hand washing, cough/sneeze in elbow, etc.)
- Campers will be assigned into small groups and will stay with their small groups for the week

Staff Guidelines during camp

- Staff will wear personal protective masks
- Staff will wash hands regularly
- Staff will do a deep disinfecting clean at the end of each day
- Camp staff will have thorough training on procedures and protocol
