Chesapeake Bay Art Association To Have Juried Exhibit at The Suffolk Center

The Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts will host the Chesapeake Bay Art Association's Spring Members Show beginning Thursday, May 11 and closing on June 17.

The exhibit will feature more than 25 artists in watercolor, oil, acrylic, photography, pottery, and 3-D mixed media. In addition, several high school students have been invited to participate and will receive awards for their work.

The John B. Tenney Memorial Art Scholarship will be announced at the opening reception on Thursday, May 11 from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. The CBAA is the only local art organization to award college scholarships to talented graduating seniors who plan to further their education in art. Every year over 50 area schools are invited to submit work for the scholarship program.

The Chesapeake Bay Art Association was founded in 1961 when 15 local artists met to form an art guild. CBAA hosts a Spring Members Show as well as the Ocean View Art Show, Virginia's oldest and largest artist-run art show, which will soon celebrate 55 years.

The exhibits will be in both the Norfolk Foundation and BB&T Galleries at the Suffolk Center.
