THEME The Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts invites you to apply to participate in “A Tribute to Peace,” an exhibit of artwork focusing on Unity, Hope, Gratitude, and Compassion. This exhibition coincides with the arrival of the Kyiv City Ballet of Ukraine to the Suffolk Center on September 19th – 22nd. This exhibit brings into fruition the challenging times we have seen in our country and around the world. In challenging times such as these, honoring peace and tranquility through art is utmost important. Artists featuring two- and three-dimensional pieces that project their visions of peacefulness will be accepted, whether it be a bright and cheerful landscape, a colorful floral, or a portrait of someone in a tranquil pose.

OUR GALLERIES Witness the mastery of visual artists in our gallery space! Suffolk Center’s award-winning BB&T Gallery and Norfolk Foundation Gallery host an ever-changing array of local and regional exhibitions. The galleries feature beautiful natural light 14-foot ceilings, which have been awarded BEST ART GALLERY GOLD by Coastal Virginia Magazine for both Southside and Peninsula area art galleries, as well as BEST ART GALLERY by the Suffolk News Herald. Suffolk Center Art Exhibitions are FREE and OPEN to the public, Tuesday – Saturday, 10am – 4pm.

AWARDS When exhibiting in the exhibition there is an opportunity for you to be voted favorite piece of artwork in “A Tribute to Peace” People’s Choice Award.

ELIGIBILITY Up to three (3) works of any medium not previously exhibited in Jesters Gallery Shop or at the Suffolk Center may be entered. Artwork must be original. **SCCA reserves the right to refuse entry of works with unusual installation or works otherwise judged unsuitable.**

PREPARATION OF WORK Two-dimensional works must be framed or gallery-wrapped, and ready to hang with wire and screw eyes. No other hanging system will be allowed and those with other hanging apparatus will not be accepted into the exhibition.

SALES Works are for sale unless specified otherwise by the artist. A commission of 40% will be retained by SCCA on all sales. Work will be sold at the price listed on the entry form. All items must remain on display until the end of the show unless other arrangements were made before the start of the exhibition. Occasionally, patrons ask for referral to a particular artist whose work they admire. A referral percentage of 20% is charged for works sold through referral. The artist will receive 80% of the transaction. All payments are processed through Jester's.

ENTRY APPLICATION Artists should complete the attached entry form giving all information requested. Participation is open to any artist, amateur or professional. However, it will be juried to determine appropriateness to the theme and to meet the SCCA's standards. Please identify each piece with the labels provided on page 4, have these tags attached to the back of each item of art before submitting. **ENTRY DEADLINE: AUGUST 23, 2022.**
