You may drop off your food items with a volunteer greeting you as you arrive.

Parking - Parking is available in our lot, located on the Center's property. Additional parking is available at the Obici Foundation (located next door to the Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts) and in the First Baptist Church parking lot (on the corner of Main Street and Finney Avenue). However, if you can carpool, parking will be less stressful for you.

Building Entrance - From the parking lot, follow the pergola to the building entrance. From Obici or First Baptist Church, walk to the fountain, and you will see a sign directing you to our main entrance. Once you get inside, you may use the elevator or the stairs to the second floor.

Dinner Theater Guests - Art's Kitchen will open at 6:00 PM for dinner. Menu options are available on our website - www.suffolkcenter.org. When you arrive, you will be given your drink tickets, which may be used in the restaurant and/or for the performance. Each drink ticket is suitable for a beverage of your choice. However, specialty and top-shelf drinks will require two tickets. Additional beverages may be purchased. *Please note that gratuities are not included in the dinner package, and we ask that you tip your server accordingly before leaving the restaurant.*

Party Theater Guests – Your event will be held in the Norfolk Foundation Gallery on the second floor, outside the Birdsong Theater. The doors to ticket holders will open at 6:30 PM.

Theater Opening and Concessions - Doors to the theater will open at 7:30 PM. Please have your tickets out and available for the ushers. Concessions will be available for purchase and may be taken to the theater for enjoyment during the performance. *You can also avoid the intermission line by pre-ordering your beverages and having them waiting for you at the intermission.*

Restrooms – Both men's and women's bathrooms are on the second floor. Please refer to directional signage or ask one of our volunteers should you need assistance.
