THEME Strike, Shape & Sculpt: Contemporary works in Ceramics, Glass and Metal

This exhibition invites artists to showcase their 3D creations, ranging from forged metal and glass to shaping clay and earthen minerals. The exhibition will be juried with 5 free standing sculptures admitted and 20 sculptures admitted.

ELIGIBILITY

Up to two (2) works not previously exhibited at the Suffolk Center may be entered. Artwork must be original, and it will be juried to determine appropriateness to the theme. SCCA reserves the right to refuse entry of works deemed unsuitable for the gallery capacity. **ENTRY DEADLINE December 7, 2024.**

ARTWORK IMAGES

Please submit high resolution images as this will aid in determining if your work has been approved to be in the exhibition. You will receive confirmation via email notating your acceptance by December 14th, 2024.

OUR GALLERIES

The Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts has 2 gallery spaces: Norfolk Foundation Gallery and TowneBank Gallery. **This exhibition will be featured only in the Norfolk Foundation Gallery.** Each gallery features a beautiful natural light 14-foot ceiling. Suffolk Center's Art Exhibitions are FREE and OPEN to the public, Tuesday-Saturday, 10am-4pm.

PREPARATION OF ARTWORK

All 3D artwork in said medium is acceptable. If your work intends to be on a pedestal, it **cannot** exceed the following dimensions: 16 inches length X 18 inches wide X 32 inches height. If the sculpture is meant to stand on its own, it **cannot** exceed the following dimensions: 5 feet length x 6 feet wide and 6 feet height. For flat sculpture work or installation artwork, they must be prepared with a wire hanging apparatus to hang by our wire hanging system.

SALES

If you desire to sell your work, a commission of 40% will be retained by SCCA on all sales and artist will receive 60% of the sale. All items must remain on display until the end of the exhibition unless other arrangements were made. All payments are processed through at the Suffolk Center.
